Peter is involved with virtual and in person pastoral support, teaching, evangelism, and discipleship. Peter attended Hillendale Bible Chapel as he grew up.

**John & Jolene Zeigenfuse. River Valley Ranch (RVR), MD** – John and Jolene serve at River Valley Ranch, commonly referred to as RVR. John currently directs the Internship Program and all Corporate Experiences for the ministry. He has been instrumental in building RVR's Summer Camping Programs, off-site Day Camps and Outpost Camps, Outdoor Education programs, Programmed Retreats (such as Winter Melt-down) and Special Events. The pandemic forced RVR to cancel most programs in 2020 and run modified, smaller versions in 2021. In spite of this, over 7,000 people have been impacted this year through RVR programs, and John was directly involved in all of them. John is also a Hillendale alumnus.
