They use friendship evangelism with contacts they make while teaching English in multiple venues as well as working with students in the school for the blind. Mike and Terri work with home groups of Christians providing discipleship, pastoring, and teaching. Two of their adult children are in other Central Asian countries doing similar outreaches.

The Zahrias are also engaged in a teaching program using Emmaus Correspondence School courses.
