

Tainla and Imsutoshi (Toshi) Jamir – Dimapur, Nagaland (Northeast), India – Orphan care, evangelism, church planting, senior care through Caring Neighborhood Ministries. The Nagamese New Testament is complete and in the hands of the Nagamese Christians. Toshi is now translating the Old Testament into Nagamese. Please also pray for Tainla's joint pain issues and for them being able to handle a difficult ward of the state.

Helen Peters - serves with the Christian Missionary Fellowship of India with her sons, daughter, and son-in-law. Located in Mysore in Southern India, they are involved with Church planting, Education, Children's Home, and Evangelism.
