Biblical Eldership Resources – vision is to promote biblical eldership for the glory of God by providing teaching, resources, training and mentoring for current and future church leaders who will implement, practice, teach and train others in biblical eldership as the model for church leadership. “In other words, we are equipping one generation of elders to equip the next generation of elders who will in turn equip the following generation.”

Brian Donohue, Cuirim Outreach – The Cuirim Outreach is a place of discipleship to Jesus; where, in the context of community, people can learn the ways of Jesus. There is a beautiful and strong partnership between the Cuirim House ministry and the local Mexican Church. Over the many years Brian, his family and others have established friendships with those in the community. Over the years FRBC has sent several mission groups to Cuirim House to help Brian, minister to the locals and edify the group members.

All Bible in Community, ABC - is a ministry to get the word of God into the communities throughout Rwanda. This is accomplished by holding training sessions for pastors, supporting them with Christian literature, sending some to the United States for theological schooling, starting a theological society of Rwanda, and creating a forum to get all theological organizations to work together rather than competing.
