# Missions for February: Serving in Special Areas

**Mike & Terri Blackburn** – Use English instruction as a vehicle to contact the local people. They also meet people through normal living functions, e.g., plumbers, electricians, butchers, taxi drivers, etc. They use the local's curiosity and misunderstanding of Americans or pride in their own faith to start conversations and then guide the conversation so that the local is asking questions that allow the presentation of God's word. Once initial interest is shown, hospitality is used to generate further contacts. Eventually some come to accept Christ as savior. Mike and Terri work with individual Christians providing discipleship, pastoring, and teaching. Two of their adult children are in other Central Asian countries doing similar outreaches.

**Ibrahim & Lina Zakria** – Manage a web site that contains information about Christianity and encourages seekers to ask questions. They run an active Emmaus correspondence program, provide relief to refugees along with God's message, preach and teach in churches in Jordan, Egypt, and lately Sudan, speak at conferences in the area, disciple church leaders, and help with church buildings.

**Paulette Thomas** - Works on the regional CRU staff, supporting and training other missionaries. Paulette also uses English instruction as a vehicle to contact the local people, primarily local professionals. She uses the local's curiosity and misunderstanding of Americans or pride in their own faith to start conversations allowing for the presentation of God's word. Paulette is the daughter of FRBC's Eileen James.
