Mike & Terri Blackburn – Mike and Terri are working together with three different groups to share Christ and make disciples, focusing on Uzbek and other Turkic speaking Muslims in Central Asia. They are reaching out to youth with a local believing couple. Quite a few young people have been coming to the Lord, although not all are from a Muslim background. Mike and Terri are also part of a group that is studying a Bible Overview Course, helping to train local believers to study the Bible on their own and become burdened to teach others to do the same. The third group Mike and Terri are involved with is an Uzbek speaking family which is endeavoring to start home churches. Thank you for praying for these three groups. Please also pray for their son Jesse and daughter Rebekah, who are also in this part of the world reaching out to Muslims.

Ibrahim & Lina Zakria – Manage a web site that contains information about Christianity and encourages seekers to ask questions. They run an active Emmaus correspondence program, provide relief to refugees along with God's message, preach and teach in churches in Jordan, Egypt, and lately Sudan, speak at conferences in the area, disciple church leaders, and help with church buildings.

Paulette Thomas - Paulette works with the CRU ministry in France. She uses English instruction as a vehicle to contact the local people and virtual media to meet, follow up, and disciple those to whom she ministers. Paulette uses the local's curiosity and misunderstanding of Americans or pride in their own faith to start conversations allowing for the presentation of God's word. Paulette requests that we pray for the sale of her apartment in Paris. Paulette is the daughter of FRBC's Eileen James.
