One half of the New Testament has been published in Nali. Sue continues the work of translating the remaining half of the New Testament into the Nali language. Sue works shoulder to shoulder with the translation team on Manus Island and on New Guinea Island.

Pablo & Sarah Cenepo-Torres - Pablo and Sarah have been in Trujillo, nine hours north of Lima, since 2002. They are involved in various ministries with a focus in the areas of Church Planting, Leadership Training, Discipleship, and Hospitality in cities, towns in the jungle and mountain villages.
