Steve & Barbara Shertzer – Serving at Camp Victory, AL with Bible classes, teaching in Camp Victory's on line learning modules, teaching Released Time Bible Classes in public schools, sharing the Gospel through "Cowboy Steve" programs, and camp maintenance.

Marie Dunsen Dawson – directs the Baltimore area Child Evangelism Fellowship (CEF) – CEF is a Bible-centered organization composed of born-again believers whose purpose is to evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and to establish (disciple) them in the Word of God and in a local church for Christian living.
